Software version 5.9.5.3 for the Hughes 9502 terminal is an optional upgrade with some new features including PPPoE and support for Vodafone SIMs.

Alternatively, the software can be downloaded over the air from the Inmarsat upgrade server by using the Remote SMS feature and the ATCO command `_IGETFW`.

New Features

- Added support for PPP over Ethernet (PPPoE). Refer to the updated User Guide (Rev J) and Inmarsat PPPoE documentation for more details.
- Added support for operation with Vodafone SIMs.
- Added a configurable subnet mask for use in Relay Mode on the IP Settings web page.
- Added a configuration for Ethernet port Duplex operation on the Ethernet settings web page.
- Reverted the `at_isig` response to an integer value to avoid issues with certain external devices.
- Improved performance on PXA270 based platforms.
- Added support for Preferred Satellite info.
- The release includes BPS 2.4.15.
- The SVN for this release is 18.

Known Issues

- Remote SMS should not contain a standalone CR or LF. CR and LF are not required in remote SMS, but if included, should be part of a CR/LF pair.
